

NEWS RELEASE BACKGROUND

Province helps small communities build for the future

The Province has approved 47 new Towns for Tomorrow projects that will share \$17.2 million. With this final round of grants, the program has now funded 201 infrastructure projects in communities throughout British Columbia, with a total investment of close to \$70 million since 2007.
